



#3 The Curriculum

The My Brothers' Teacher curriculum is divided into eight units, each with a culminating project-based assessment.

Unit 1: Self- Identity

Students will understand how their identities are socially constructed and will define their structural, social, and personal identity.

Unit 2: Connecting the Culture

Students will examine the history of education in this country, dating back to the 1600's while further exploring their very own cultural heritage. They will be able to draw connections between our ancestors and who we are today.

Unit 3: Community Pedagogy

Students will examine historical pedagogy dating back to the 1600's, specifically focusing on ways in which we learned and the power of circles.

Unit 4: Resisting Marginalization Through Community Organizing

Students will examine the power of community organizing as an act of resistance, empowerment, and change throughout history. They will consider the tenants of community organizing as a pedagogical approach.

Unit 5: Creative Pedagogy

Students will explore different pedagogical approaches, including liberation pedagogy, Pentecostal pedagogy, and Hip Hop pedagogy.

Unit 6: Pedagogy in Practice

Students will get hands-on pedagogical experience by observing teaching in action and developing their own mock lesson.

Unit 7: Educators as Change Agents

Students will consider the legacy and impact they would like to have as an educator.

Unit 8: Youth Participatory Action Research

Students will engage in a Youth Participatory Action Research Project related to education.
